



What is the Bridge Project?

Clarity understands that in order for a new believer to truly experience real and lasting life change in Jesus, they must become connected and involved in a local church body.

Although Clarity is a para-church organization and exists in part to share the gospel, we recognize that we are not a church.

For clients who have come to know the Lord, or are actively seeking Him due to their involvement at Clarity, the Bridge Project was created to facilitate a seamless transition from a connection at Clarity to a connection in the Church.

What Does My Church's Involvement Look Like?

Partnering with Clarity through the Bridge Project will follow this basic timeline:

- Each church recruits at least two (or more!) volunteers who have a heart to reach out to the "least of these" in our community.
- Participants will attend training session(s) that fit within the church's preferences and schedule.
- When a client comes to know the Lord at Clarity, is seeking Him, or is interested in attending church, we would refer them to one of our "Bridge" churches.
- Bridge Project participants would then be able to effectively disciple the client and help him or her to truly get "plugged-in" to the church.
- Eventually the Clarity client would (ideally) be able to move towards greater self-sufficiency and be a true disciple of Christ on his or her own.
