
OUR MISSION:

EXPANDED HOURS

Clarity Solutions expanded its hours for our clinic and support programs to include Thursday evenings to accommodate working parents and our increase in clients.



EXPANDED & IMPROVED CAMPUS

Clarity Solutions is in the process of acquiring and renovating 110 E. Memorial Dr. to serve as an administrative building. Windows at The Haven were also replaced.



EXPANDED CARE

Clarity Solutions has expanded its client support programs, now allowing participants to access education, mentoring, and resources until their child turns two.

ABUNDANT HOME

The Haven reached capacity for the first time in 2024. Most of the year it was full, with 3–4 moms and 3–5 babies! Clients successfully transitioned out of the home, saw reunification with children, began working, celebrated sobriety, and more.



ABUNDANT SUPPORT

This year, God blessed Clarity with \$1,056,266 in income, driven by the generosity of our supporters and record giving at our gala, Walk for Life, and end-of-year appeals, sustaining the abundant growth we experienced in 2024.



ABUNDANT SERVICE

Clarity was blessed to hire and train an additional staff nurse, growing our capacity to provide exceptional care and support to our patients.

Clarity Solutions 2024 theme was *Abundant Life*. This theme was evident as God showed up in amazing ways for Clarity Solutions and the clients we served. What is most important about these notable accomplishments is that they represent countless miracle babies, family transformations, and answered prayers.

Medical Clinic.

93% of clients chose life!

427

MEDICAL CLIENTS

Clarity served 427 individual women at Clarity's Clinic in 2024. This is up 23% in two years.

707

APPOINTMENTS

The clinic had 707 appointments for medical services in 2024. This includes 242 appointments for abortion-minded women.

149

ABORTION-MINDED WOMEN

We served 21% more abortionminded women in 2024 over 2023. There is also a 344% 5-year increase with these women. 302

CHOICES FOR LIFE

76% of clients were seeking or at risk for abortion

302 lives were saved in 2024! Clarity served 324 women who were considering or at-risk for abortion.



The Haven Maternity Home.

2,417

NIGHTS OF SHELTER

The Haven provided 2,417 nights of shelter to her residents in 2024. This is up 266% from 2023.

RESIDENTS SERVED

Six moms and seven babies were housed, loved, and provided for in 2024.

53

CLIENTS WITH UNSTABLE HOUSING

Ninety-two percent of these clients without housing stability were considering or at-risk for abortion. The need for The Haven continues.

These figures represent moms who made professions of faith, were gainfully employed, worked towards their education, and more. The babies that call The Haven home were born into sober, loving families, or were reunited with their birth mother due to Clarity's ministry.

159

ASPIRE CLIENTS

159 women participated in our Aspire program. Clarity ended 2024 with 82 active program participants.

1,505

ASPIRE APPOINTMENTS

These appointments include class, mentoring, and Bible study. This is up 20% from 2023.

22

MENTORS

We have 22 female mentors helping, encouraging, and guiding the women in the Aspire program.

HISPANIC INITIATIVES

We sourced multiple new mentors and class materials to support our Spanish-only speaking clients. Our mentors are also teaching two clients to read and write.

MALE CLIENTS

Clarity served a record 196 men in 2024. These men came through the clinic, the Aim program, or were court referrals.

572

MALE APPOINTMENTS

These appointments consisted of dad classes. mentoring, and medical meetings.

ABORTION-MINDED DADS

Men's Director, Jack Daniel Taylor, met with 34 dads involved in an abortion decision.

Dad Classes expanded to twice a month due to growth.

HEALING AFTER ABORTION




2024 FUNDING




The Abortion-Minded Client.
