VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES



Thank you for your interest in the ministry of Clarity. Listed below are opportunities available and a brief description of each position. Each position requires the completion of initial and ongoing training.

Family Support

Mentor: A mother with Titus 2 attributes that would meet one-on-one with clients, build a relationship, and share/apply the Truth of God's Word to their situation. The mentor would give guidance on godly motherhood.

Teacher: Present approved client curricula in a group setting.

Teaching Assistant: Assist teacher by tabulating points in client's Aspire folder, helping schedule client's classes, escort clients to classroom, helping maintain order and control during class, escort clients to Points Place at end of class.

Point Place Associate/Donations Processor: Provide a pleasant shopping experience for our clients by providing a warm welcome, assisting with finding items, recording points spent; maintaining a clean, orderly environment by helping to sort donated items, stocking merchandise and straightening as needed after clients have shopped. Help change out seasonal clothing items.

Facility Care: Maintain a clean, welcoming environment for our clients by performing light housekeeping duties on a weekly or rotating basis.

Men's Mentor: This is a godly father who would meet one-on-one with men who are expectant fathers or new fathers to speak truth into their lives. The mentor would give guidance on godly fatherhood.

Men's Teacher: Present approved curricula in a group setting.

Medical Clinic

Client Care Assistant: Assist nurses with client check-in, clerical duties, chaperone ultrasounds, light housekeeping and laundry.

Office Nurse: R.N.-Perform pregnancy tests, basic health assessment and individual health education.

4.
