VOLUNTEER OPPORTUNITIES



Thank you for your interest in supporting Clarity's ministry! Listed below are various volunteer opportunities, along with a brief description of each position. Each position requires initial and ongoing training.

Client-Facing Positions

Women's Mentor: Meet one-on-one with moms in the Aspire program, building relationships, applying God's Truth to their lives, and providing Biblical motherhood advice.

Men's Mentor: Meet one-on-one with expectant or new dads in the AIM program, sharing God's Truth and showing them how to be Godly men and fathers.

Class Instructor: Teach parenting or life skills classes. (If you have experience teaching or knowledge of a certain topic, let us know!)

Instructor's Assistant: Help the Class Instructor with various logistical and organizational tasks.

AIM Instructor: Teach the specific dad classes in our AIM men's program.

Points Place Volunteer: Help clients shop our boutique by providing a warm welcome, answering questions, and tracking points; sort donations and restock inventory; keep the boutique tidy.

Medical Clinic Liaison: Chaperone client ultrasounds and assist with housekeeping and office duties as needed.

Behind-the-Scenes Positions

Housekeeper: Perform light housekeeping on a weekly or rotating basis.

Interpreter: Facilitate bilingual communication between clients and staff.

Mailing Team Member: Periodically prepare supporter mailings for distribution.

Handyman: Help with various repairs or maintenance projects on campus as needed.

Prayer Positions

On-Site Prayer Partner: Pray for Clarity on campus at one of our designated prayer rooms for a one-hour time slot during business hours.

4.
